Attend one of the training sessions held the week of March 21st to prepare for your new role. Specific training information will be available for each ministry area at their respective concourse counters.

You're in the game. Join your team and serve!

EARLY CHILDHOOD MINISTRY

Preschool Volunteers serve one service, once a month. Volunteers build relationships with preschoolers, lead them in games and activities, and accompany them to GreenHouse for worship and teaching.

Nursery & Toddler Volunteers serve one service, one Sunday a month. Volunteers care for infants and toddlers, helping them understand that church is a loving and safe place.

GreenHouse Worship Leaders serve at both the 9:00 & 10:15 services for one month each quarter. Volunteers help preschoolers worship God through singing and dancing.

ELEMENTARY MINISTRY

The Wild Small Group Leaders serve during one service every Sunday, every other quarter. During *The Wild*, our worship experience for elementary kids, leaders interact with kids, help them discuss what they've learned, and guide them on their faith journey.

The Dive Team serves during one service every Sunday, every other quarter. During *The Dive*, a unique experience for kids who stay multiple services, volunteers help kids dive deeper into each Sunday's theme through special activities and projects.

The Wild Tech Team works together to use sound, video, and lighting to enhance each week's theme. Volunteers serve every Sunday throughout the morning for an entire month and then have two months off.

The Wild Worship Team helps kids worship God for who He is and what He has done. Lead and background vocalists are encouraged to inquire about this team. Volunteers serve every Sunday throughout the morning for an entire month and then have two months off.

The Wild Prep Team serves during the week and ensures the stage, materials, and room are ready for Sunday. Designers, builders, artists, and also those with administrative and organizational skills are encouraged to join this team.

WORSHIP

Vocalists rehearse and help lead worship with the contemporary praise team. Sign-up to learn more about the commitments and expectations for this leadership role.

Guitar Players, both electric and acoustic, are needed to help lead worship in our contemporary services. Sign-up to learn more about the commitments and expectations for this leadership role.

Hospitality Volunteers serve on a rotation, and provide food and beverages for the worship and tech teams.

Production Assistants serve once a month, and assist with Sunday morning service coordination. Volunteers with administrative gifts and great people skills are ideal. No musical/artistic skills necessary.

GUEST SERVICES

Assisted Parking Volunteers offer valet parking services at the South Entrance for anyone needing assistance into the building. Volunteers serve once a month, before and after two worship services.

Communion & Offering Servers play a vital role in our Sunday worship services, serving communion and collecting offering. Volunteers serve once a month, at either the first two or latter two services.

Ushers & Greeters welcome all who enter our doors, helping them find their way and ensuring a great first experience for guests. Volunteers serve once a month, at either the first two or the latter two services.

Guest Central Volunteers serve as traffic control directors on Sunday mornings, during one service once a month.
