

HABITS OF A GREAT JHM GROUP LEADER

- 1. GROWS themselves and shares out of their own growth.
- 2. JUMPS IN and actively participates WITH the kids.
- 3. NOTICES new or lonely students and reaches out.
- 4. PREPARES to bring the right balance of fun and focus.
- 5. PRAYS at least weekly for each of their students.
- 6. CALLS each of their students up to a next step.

JUMPING IN - to actively and fully engage in serving and supporting students

JHM groups are not *just* for students. They are opportunities for leaders to learn from and pour into the next generation of Christ followers.

- Active participation
 - o During games, discussion, and free time
- Building relationships
 - o Get to know them personally and understand their needs/challenges
- Passion
 - Be genuine
- Taking initiative
 - \circ $\;$ Seek opportunities to lead or help where/when needed $\;$
