



Satisfied – A Series from the 23rd Psalm Field Guide

The path we take matters. It determines where we land. Wrong path = wrong destination. Right path = right destination. Be confident that you're on the right path by following the Good Shepherd.

Scripture:

He refreshes my soul.
He guides me along the right paths
for his name's sake.
Psalm 23:3

Ice Breaker and Intro Question:

1. Have you ever been on a road trip and gotten really lost? Share with your group what happened.
2. What resonated with you from Sunday's service? (Sermon, scripture, song, etc.)

Discussion Questions

3. Read Psalm 23:3 quietly by yourself. Give everyone a minute to reflect on the passage. Last week we covered the first half of this passage, but the second half has a definite shift. What can we learn from that?

4. Eddie shared, “your path determines your direction and your direction determines your destination.” How have you seen this to be true in your life?
5. Read Romans 3:21 together as a group. How does this verse both convict and comfort you?
6. Eddie also shared, “The right path is not just seeking to avoid things that are obviously wrong – it is seeking to do everything we can possibly do that is right....the most righteous thing you can do is love.” Take a moment to identify an area or person where you sense God nudging you to do the right thing – to love. Share with the group, if you’re willing. Close your group time by praying for these people and places.
