ONLINE WORSHIP CHECKLIST

Here are a few practical ideas for how to make online worship awesome!

CREATE A SPACE

Be intentional about arriving a few minutes early and making sure your environment will allow you to be present without distraction. Say a short prayer or do something that helps you remember that you're not merely tuning in to observe, but you're showing up to be with God and with others for worship.

PREPARE FOR CELEBRATING COMMUNION

Prepare communion elements ahead of time, if possible, so that you're ready to participate in that special part of the service each week. The bread and the juice is a physical reminder of our connection and communion with Jesus and with the church!

PARTICIPATE

However you're willing to actively participate in the service, jump right in! Sing along with the songs, take communion, fill out your Connection Card, and greet others in the chat. Look up the Scripture verses in your Bible or on a Bible app. Use the Sermon Notes page to take notes during the message.

CONNECT WITH OTHER WESTSIDERS

In addition to the chat feature during the online service, think about reaching out to someone who comes to mind with a quick text or message. Say good morning to someone you miss or reach out to someone you have served with. If you're worshiping alone, try to connect with someone for a phone call or video conversation. Small connections like this really do matter!

INVITE OTHERS TO WORSHIP

Share a link on social media to invite your friends to worship. Engage with West Side's social media posts by sharing and commenting. Post a photo or a story of your worship experience (and tag us) as a way of sharing with others!
